- Any personal medication or strapping needs
- Hand Sanitiser and Mask

Other Information:

Due to Covid-19, we are required to wear a face mask in areas where this is mandated, by law.



Hand sanitiser stations and hand washing facilities in the toilets will be available at the venue. However, we do ask you to also bring your own.

Please during Training keep 2m where possible and limit touching your face and others.

During the Session

If you would like to stay and watch for safeguarding reasons you are welcome to but due to current restrictions, you will have to stay on the tarmac area and it is limited to one person per player.

- filming and photography to take place on the day and we may ask some players to be interviewed - only if they are happy to be, please inform someone if consent is withheld.

What if it rains?

The session will take place if there is light drizzle and we will continue to monitor the forecast leading up to the event. If in the event the weather is not kind to us we will make a decision on the morning of the event - please attend even if there is a bit of rain around and unless we tell you otherwise, we will do everything we can to ensure the session goes ahead.

Temperature scanning on site.
